Hope ya all enjoy your paper, and we get all the support to keep our paper the best in the Fleet.

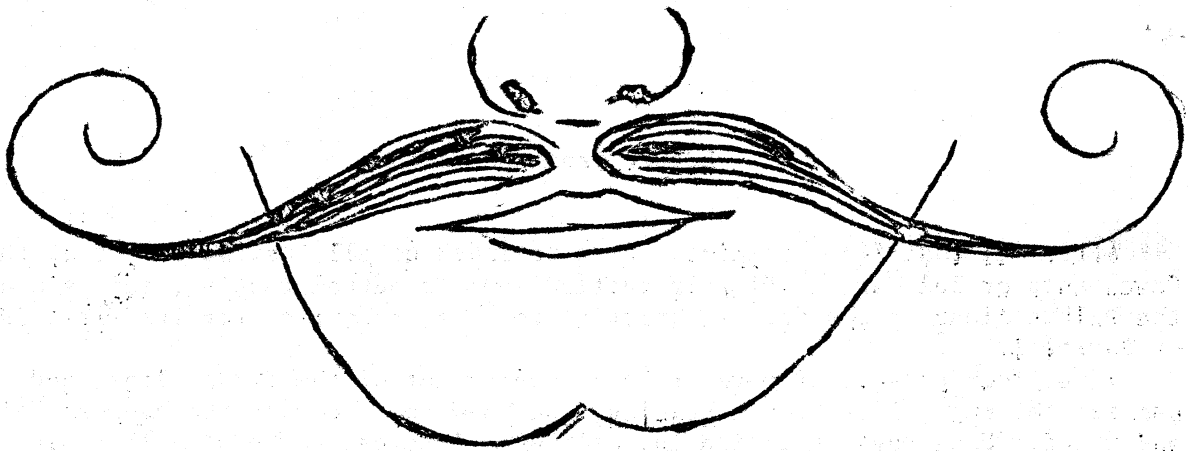
